Sunday Kapi'olani Park Sales and Support

Dates: January 3, February 21, March 6, March 20, April 3
Times: Arrive 1:00pm, finish & depart no later than 3:30pm
Location: Kapi'olani Park Bandstand, Waikīkī

Role(s): Sales and support at the bandstand do not occur every Sunday but when they do occur our sales tables, decorations, and souvenirs are set up prior to the beginning of the 2:00 concert. Most sales take place when the concert ends, then everything is packed up and stored beneath the bandstand. Easy, on-the-spot instructions will make you feel like an old pro on your first day. This is a great way to help support the band, as 100% of all sales profits go to the band.
